

To listen to [KTNA FM](#) online:

If you have a [PC](#), your default audio player is usually Windows Media or Real Player.

When you click on [Listen Online](#), you get to a pls file (listen.pls).

Right click to open the pls file in a particular program (whatever your default audio player is). Direct it to SAVE the file in that player.

If you have a [Mac](#), your default audio player is usually iTunes. The listen.pls file should open automatically with iTunes.

PLS is a computer file format that stores multimedia [playlists](#). It is a more expressive format than basic [M3U](#), as it can store ([cache](#)) information on the song title and length (this is supported in extended M3U only). With PLS version 2, playlists also include a PLS version declaration.

[iTunes](#), [QuickTime Player](#), [RealPlayer](#), [Winamp](#), [AIMP](#), [XBMC](#), [XMPlay](#), [VLC media player](#), popular GNU/Linux media player [Rhythmbox](#), and [foobar2000](#) are able to interpret PLS files.^{*[citation needed]*} [Media Player Classic](#) with the [K-Lite](#) codec installed does work with PLS format but still requires the appropriate [MIME](#) or [file extension associations](#).
