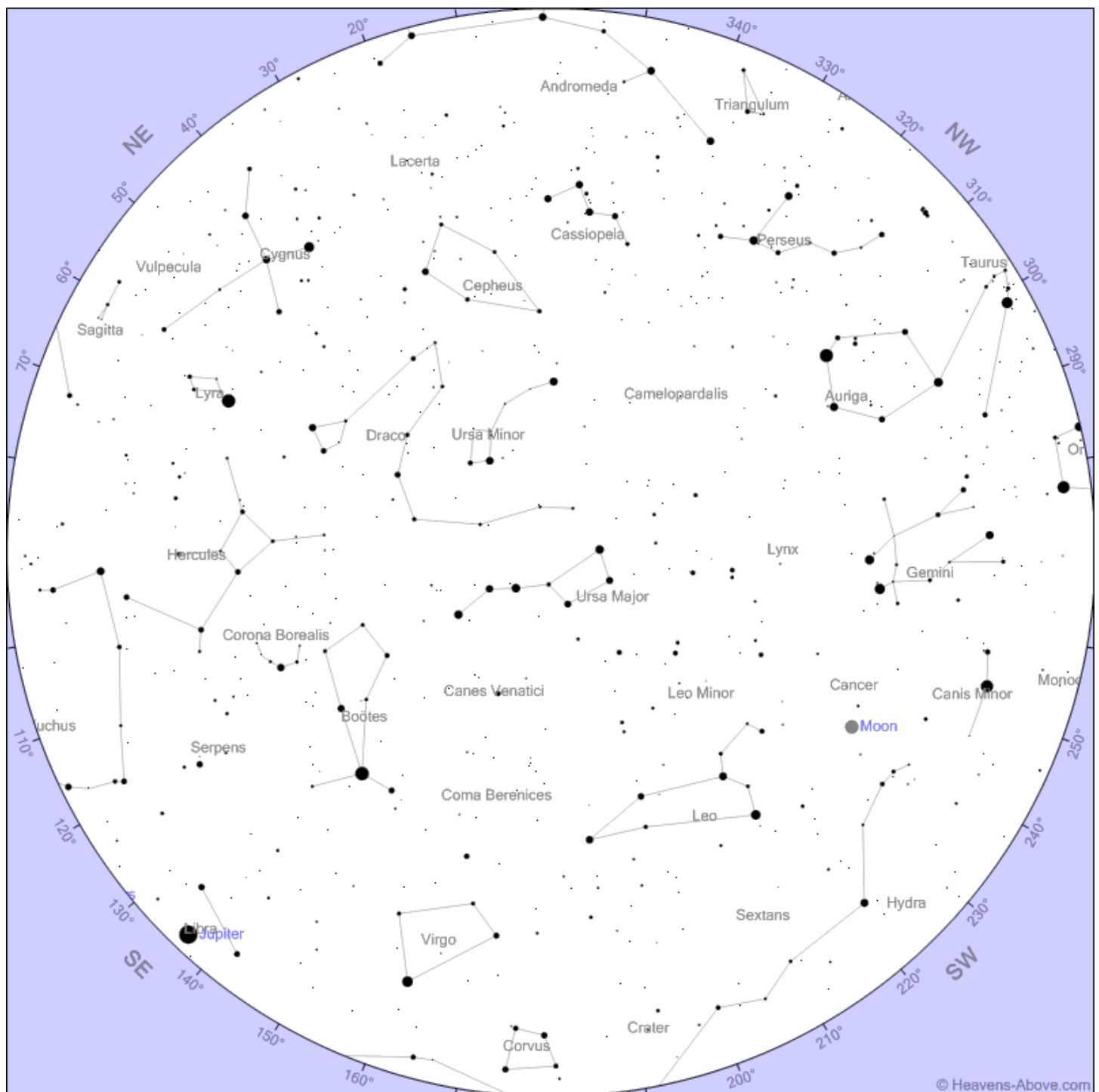


This chart shows the sky for the Upper Susitna Valley at mid-eclipse, 4:30 am 1/31/18.



To use a star chart, hold it above you with the direction you are facing at the bottom.

Notice that bright Jupiter has just risen in the SE, and will climb a little higher as the morning progresses. It gets about 10 degrees above due south around 7:30 am.
