



Visual aids to accompany SDS 11-12-23, to explain why constellations don't disappear into the sunset during fall months at latitude 62 degrees north.


Looking WEST at the SAME time each night.



10pm Sept 1




10pm Oct 1




10pm Nov 1

THESE charts are all a consistent 1 hour after sunset, early in Nautical Twilight.


